2.As the number of applicants to J-PAC has increased rapidly in recent years, we will consider whether the student exchange is a mutual exchange and whether there is a balance between acceptance and sending when making selections.

3.If there have been no students from Chiba University who have studied abroad at your university either physically or online in the past five years (starting from 2020), we may ask you to adjust the number of students accepted. After the nomination sheet deadline, we will inform you of the number of people who can be accepted by March 31th .

4.Please strictly adhere to the nomination and application deadline.
